What is a Borderline Personality Disorder (BPD) MHPN Network?

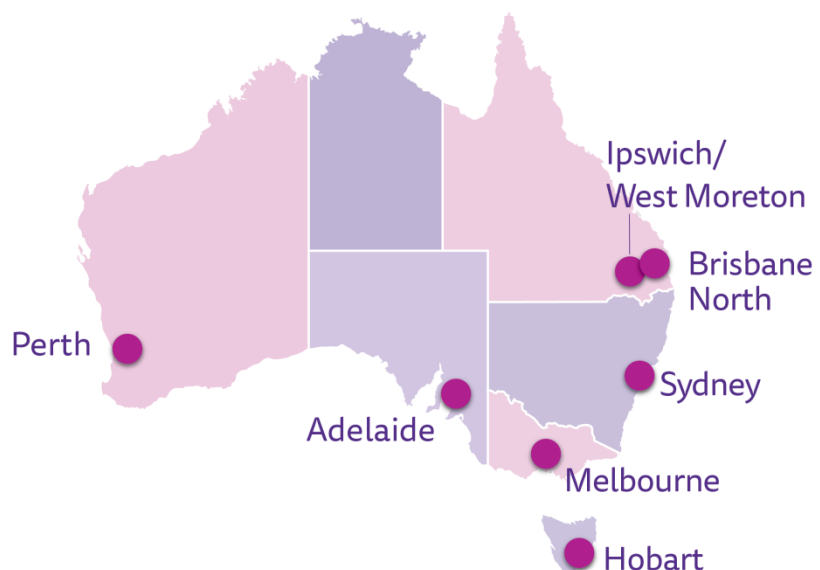
